2ND GRADE SCIENCE	
OVERVIEW	This unit focuses on the American presidents. The class learn about the American presidents by choosing one president of their choice to research and post for the class to see on Yazzem. In the computer labs, the students will have the chance to research information and stories about their president. They will make a Yazzem account and post their information. The students will be able to see other student's presidents and comment on their information.
OBJECTIVE	Students learn about the presidents. The students will have books and the computer lab open to them to research and post information on Yazzem. Students will demonstrate their knowledge of their president posted on Yazzem with 90% accuracy.

PROCEDURE

I will begin the lesson by asking the students some introduction questions about presidents.

- Who was the first president?
- Who is the president right now?
- Can anyone name any presidents?
- How many presidents have we had?

The students will choose a president of their choice. The students will research and find information on their president. The information must include: birth date, death, when they served presidency, what was one thing they did during presidency and fun facts.

After a few days of research, the students will sign up for a Yazzem account and will post information about their president. The students will be graded on the post of their president and the comments on other student's posts.
