

Objective	To read a text and write a reflective response with a minimum of 100 words, and actively join in class discussion about it.
Materials	<p>Teacher needs: Computers with internet access, project rubric.</p> <p>Student needs: Computers with internet access.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Divide up characters' parts from the text. • Reserve computer lab or media center.
Note to teacher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a rubric for how the presentation will be graded. • Make sure you tell the students exactly where and how to edit the page. • Make sure students know to include their name in their posting.
Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have class meet in the reserved computer lab. 2. Have students read the text by roles. 3. Direct students to Sauropol page http://www.sauropol.com 4. Make sure you tell the students exactly when and how to edit the page. 5. It may be helpful to have student write their response in a Word document and then paste it onto the Saropol page. 6. Make sure students know to include their name in their posting.
Evaluation	<p>Students will receive full credit for writing and posting a response to the text.</p> <p>Students will be expected to contribute to class discussion, showing thoughtful reflection about the text and/or classmates' postings.</p>
