<ul style="list-style-type: none">• OBJECTIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To each elementary students how to navigate to different websites.• The students will be able to find the site.• They will fill out the invitations with appropriate information.• Students will email invitations.• Students will complete this with 95% accuracy.
