



The Civil War

<p>Objective</p> 	<p>Students will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Discuss major differences online between the North and South and how these differences led to the Civil War• Examine conflicting opinions about Abraham Lincoln during the Civil War.• Explore and analyze a famous speech or writing by Abraham Lincoln• Post a video of yourself discussing these points onto http://corp.kaltura.com/
<p>Materials</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i><u>The Civil War: A Nation Divided</u></i> program• Computer with Internet access• Web Cam• Resources about the Civil War and Abraham Lincoln.
<p>Procedure</p>	<p>After watching <i><u>The Civil War: A Nation Divided</u></i> , create an online video at the Kaltura website that discusses how regional differences contributed to the outbreak of the Civil War. Discuss the events during 1860 and 1861 that made 11 states secede. Discuss conflicting opinions of Abraham Lincoln during the war.</p>
<p>Evaluation</p> 	<p>Evaluation</p> <p>Use the following three-point rubric to evaluate students' work during this lesson.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Three points: Students were active in class discussions; demonstrated a strong understanding of differences between the North and South, significant events leading to the Civil War, and conflicting opinions about Abraham Lincoln; created a thorough, engaging video about Lincoln's speech or writing.• Two points: Students participated in class discussions; demonstrated a

	<p>satisfactory understanding of differences between the North and South, significant events leading to the Civil War, and conflicting opinions about Abraham Lincoln; created a clear, complete video about Lincoln's speech or writing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• One point: Students did not participate in class discussions; demonstrated a weak understanding of differences between the North and South, significant events leading to the Civil War, and conflicting opinions about Abraham Lincoln; created a vague or inaccurate video about Lincoln's speech or writing.
