

# Lesson Plan Example #1

## Subject: Spelling

Grade: 3

<b>Overview</b>	The purpose of this lesson plan is to test the students on whether or not they have mastered the spelling list for the week. They should have taken the list home and practiced the words with their parents and also should have completed the various other activities that incorporated these specific words throughout the week.
<b>Objectives</b>	Students will show that they have successfully mastered the material and have the ability to correctly spell the words in the future.
<b>Standards</b>	3.1-Students will be able to use words they've learned while reading. 3.6-Students will be able to spell out and write the words.
<b>Materials</b>	-Computer for utilization of survey -Spelling list for each student (handed out at the beginning of the week)
<b>Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Provide each child, at the beginning of the week, with a list of words that will be used in the survey that is to be completed during class time on Friday.</li><li>2. Instruct the students to practice spelling these words at home with their parents and to also complete the homework activities that incorporate the words.</li><li>3. During the week complete various activities during class that use the words on the list. Make sure to point it out and explain the context and meaning in each case.</li><li>4. On Friday provide each student with either a laptop or a computer and have them complete the survey over the words.</li><li>5. Upon completion and grading go over any common mistakes that the class might have had and answer any questions.</li></ol>
<b>Evaluation</b>	The survey is the evaluation.
