



A FARMER'S SCHEDULE

Grade 4

<p><u>OVERVIEW</u></p>	<p>In this activity, students will be given a list of farm chores that must be completed in a timely fashion. In groups, the students are to use Toodledo to create their own schedules in a manner that will save travel time between tasks.</p>
<p><u>OBJECTIVES</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will learn the importance of time management.• Students will learn what farm animals eat.• Students will learn what typical farm animals produce.
<p><u>MATERIALS</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toodledo Account• Computer Access• A Small Farm• List of assigned farm chores• Printer

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PROCEDURE</u></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students divide into groups of 3-5.2. One member of each group signs up for a Toodledo account.3. Students take turns creating a new task for each of the chores listed on the assignment sheet.4. The children must organize their schedules in a way that saves time based on proximity of one task to the next.5. The groups must then print their To-Do lists.6. After receiving proper instruction, the students are to work within their groups to complete each task on the farm.
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>EVALUATION</u></p>	<p>Once all of the groups have completed their tasks, have the students explain why they organized their schedule the way they did and if it saved them time. Students will listen to their classmates' stories about their chores on the farm and all that they have learned.</p>
