Title and Grade Level Overview

World War II Project and Toodledo Project

High School American History

The purpose of this lesson is for the students to research and share their knowledge on World War II. It is a two part project and the second part is for the students to organize their project using Toodledo. This will also teach the students to stay organized and be on task while completing this project.

Objective

After using the Toodledo website, students will be able to stay organized and always be on task.

Standard

This project covers the standard USH.5.3 and USH.5.4 which is about America's involvement in World War II. This standard should be covered in a High School American History Class.

Materials

- Computer (with internet access)
- American History Textbook
- Any Research Students have made for project
- Poster boards, pamphlets, and anything else needed to make the students project
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Procedure

The procedure for the students learning in this lesson is mostly up to them. The website will be providing them with the tools that they need to stay on task and organize themselves. In their research they should learn plenty of extra information about WWII that is outside of their text book readings. Overall, it is up to them how much they learn and how deep they want to go into the subject.

Evaluation

To evaluate the students there will be a unit test over WWII. To see what they have learned about organization from Toodledo they will have to write a reflection essay. This essay will include: what they have learned from the website, if they find the website useful, and the pros and cons of using a task manager to complete tasks.
