

Where do our Animals Friends Live?¹



Objectives	Following this activity students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Correctly identify 5 animals and where they live with 100% accuracy
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pictures of 5 different animals (Downloaded from Kontainer)• Velcro, magnets, or tape depending on area used• Pictures of 5-10 different animal habitats (Downloaded from Kontainer)
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Get the children into group time<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sing a song or read a book to start group time. Preferably one that has to do with the topic of habitats2. Have children name the different animals<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold up a picture of the bird and let them tell you what it is• Repeat for bear, fish, dog, and horse.3. Have children name the different habitats<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold up picture of the nest and have them tell you what it is• Repeat for each habitat4. Put up the different animals and have the children decide where each animal lives<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Each animal could have up to 2 habitats, ex: a bird can live in a bird cage or a nest
