

Summer Olympic Sports



Overview	Students will learn all 39 of the sports that are involved in competition in the Summer Olympics.
Objective	After reviewing the information pages on Kontainer the students will be able to name at least 80% of the sports and give the main equipment needed for the sports.

Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Upload information to introduce the topic. Here I will explain a little bit about each sport. By giving a description of each sport and what special equipment is needed to play the sport.2. Students will download the information on each sport. They will be asked to review the information, and write a essay about the

Procedures (cont.)	<p>sport they find to be the most interesting. Then they will upload their essay onto Kontainer.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Their essays will be reviewed by me, and then sent back to them via Kontainer. On their essay will be pieces of advice about what to correct in their writing.4. Students will be given a week to review the comments made on their work, and will be able to upload questions until a certain time.
Evaluation	<p>After the deadline for asking questions is up, the students are to fix their essay and resubmit it on Kontainer. Their second copy of their essay will actually be graded. Points will be award for clear explanation of why that student picked their particular sport. There should be facts about the sport in the essay.</p>
