



Día de los Muertos



Overview	Students will learn about the customs of the celebration and participate in one of the typical activities of the celebration. They will take pictures that will be uploaded to their Kontainer accounts.
Objective	After learning about this celebration, students will complete (in Spanish) a handout with various questions pertaining to the holiday, which they will upload into a file on their Kontainer accounts.
Standards	No standards can be found for Post Secondary lesson plans.
Materials	A handout will be provided that the students are required to download off of the Kontainer website that consists of the information that will be covered in class. The students may use the handout on the questions at the end of the class.
Procedure¹	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. On the handout, ask the students to name about five holidays celebrated in the United States. Record their answers on the board. Now ask the students to discuss the importance of each holiday. What values or beliefs do the holidays reflect? Have the students upload their answers to their Kontainer accounts.2. Introduce the topic of Día de los Muertos. Give background information through a video uploaded onto Kontainer.

Answers will not be graded right or wrong. However, each answer will be read over and any answers left blank will result in minus five points. Each answer is worth five points with a total of 10 questions. The handout is worth 50 points.

The overall evaluation is worth a total of 60 points.
