



Art: Identifying Techniques

<p>Overview</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The students will be able to view numerous pieces of artwork and will have to not only express their personal views about the works of art as well as identify the different techniques used.
<p>Objective</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Given a picture, the students will have to identify the numerous techniques used in different artworks with 80% accuracy.

<p>Materials</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teacher needs a 72photos account Pictures of various pieces of artwork Students need access to a computer Students each need a 72photos account
<p>Procedure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The teacher will create a gallery on her 72photos account and post a number of various pieces of artwork. The students will then also need to create a 72photos account in order to view and comment on the pictures. The students will go to the teacher's account to view the artwork. They will then write a paragraph discussing their personal opinions of each piece.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Afterwards they will then need to list all of the different techniques used within the artwork.
Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• For their evaluation, the teacher will give the students a grade on their responses based on completion/effort, as well as how accurately they were on the techniques used in each piece of artwork.
