

# Rain Forest Photography

Objectives	The objective is to show children how to use Phototrem. They are going to create their own Rainforest using pictures they have found on the internet. They have to have five different pictures of animals in the rainforest and place they onto a Rain Forest background. They have to edit each of their chosen pictures on Photorem, change the pictures color and enhance the photo however they choice.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Computer</li> <li>- Access to Internet</li> <li>- Pictures</li> </ul>
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Go onto the Internet and pick five different pictures of each animal.</li> <li>2. Save each picture you have found to your computer</li> <li>3. Open <a href="http://www.photorem.com">www.photorem.com</a></li> <li>4. Upload one at a time and edit each picture to your liking. (you have to change each pictures color, and enhance each picture however you please.)</li> <li>5. After creating each of your pictures save them back to your computer</li> <li>6. Print them out</li> <li>7. Google pictures of Rainforest and print out a large picture of the Rainforest.</li> <li>8. Place each of your newly edited photorem pictures onto the Rainforest backgrounds.</li> </ol>
Assessment	The overall goal of this project was to create and art project that could be hung around the classroom. It gave the children and oppportunity to be creative and make their own Rainforest with the animals they would like in it. After the project is complete the children need to write a paragraph about how photorem was helpful and why you chose the editing to the picture that they did.

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
