


Creative Writing

Grades:6-8

Objectives	Get middle school students engaged in learning something new and interesting
Materials	computer with Internet access students willing to learn
Procedure 	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1.) Have students get into groups of 3-4. If it takes too long, then assign groups.2.) Allow each group to get a computer and log on.3.) Tell them to go to picjuice.com once they get logged on and wait for further instructions.4.) Once everyone is logged on, tell them to create a story about someone learning about ASL culture using pictures, but the pictures cannot simply be copied and pasted. It has to be edited in some way using picjuice.com.5.) Tell them that they can get the pictures from anywhere, but if they get them from the Internet, then the website must be given at the end of the story and the original pictures must be shown in some way without ANYTHING being changed on them.6.) Tell the students that once they have their pictures edited and saved, then they need to put them on a Powerpoint presentation and tell the story in a creative way.7.) Once everyone is done, have each group present their story to the class.
Evaluation	Have each group sum up what ASL culture is and ask them if they truly understand what the culture is like.
