

Grade: A-course at upper secondary-level

Duration: 1-3 lessons

Overview: The pupils will learn differences in vocabulary between British and American English.

Objectives: The pupils will be divided into groups and will look up British or American words on the internet (depending on which group they end up in) and use Zazna to bookmark them and post them on Zazna so the other groups can see them as well. They will then be quizzed on some of these words.

Standards: The pupils will practice vocabulary and differences between British and American English.

Materials: The Internet and Zazna.

Procedure: Start with an introduction to the differences between British and American English, show examples etc and introduce Zazna. Divide the class into small groups and send them off to look up words on the internet and bookmark and post them using Zazna. The pupils will then study all of these words, and the teacher will create a quiz using some or all of the words.

Assessment: Pass – 50% correct answers on the quiz.

Pass with distinction – 75% correct answers on the quiz.

Pass with special distinction – 100% correct answers on the quiz.
