


Shakespeare Around the World: Groups Application

Grade Level: Post-Secondary

Objectives	<p>Paired with reading and studying the works of William Shakespeare, students will use Groups to report on a place around the world that has been affected by or created in honor of Shakespeare and his works.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be introduced to Shakespeare's works • Students will discover different ways in which Shakespeare's works have affected the world culturally while giving students the opportunity to communicate with other students in the group through comments and blogging.
Types of Students	Post-secondary English students
Materials	Students need access to a computer as well as a free Groups membership
Procedure 1 	<p>Students are to join the class group on Groups. Once they have joined, students are to post a photo of a place in the world affected by, dedicated to, or having to do with Shakespeare. <u>Students must cite their sources</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Example: The Shakespeare & Company bookstore- Paris, France. <p>Students will then create a blog post about the chosen location and photo. Students should be sure to include information such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where is the location? • What is it? • How does it involve Shakespeare or his works? • What is some of the history behind the subject of the photo? • How is the subject of the photo used today?
Evaluation	Students will be graded on the content of their blog and the picture posted. Students will also be graded on writing and participation.
