

Interacting about Football



Lesson Plan for High School Students Learning to use Shareflow with the Topic of Football

Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The students will have an increased knowledge of the application, Shareflow. • The students will know how to have a discussion on Shareflow.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Computer • Shareflow account <p>Alternative: Class debate as one big group in class.</p>
Procedures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Log in to student's Shareflow • Click on the debate section of the Shareflow account. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Make sure to click on the correct debate topic. • Read the paragraph review over the weekend's football games, and debate on the opinions given. • Must reply to the discussion at least once every two minutes. • Every 15 minutes (or if the topic starts to run out steam) the topic will change (changed by the instructor) to a different game. • Discussions should be about how the teams played, the team's chances of making the playoffs, injuries, and player performances.
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each student will have to participate in the debate, on Shareflow. • The debate should take up the entire class period.
Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evaluation of the debate will be based on how often each student replies, and contribution to the discussion. • Each student should post at least once every two minutes.
