

# Telling Time

Grade Level: Special Ed

Subject: Life Skills/ Telling Time

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<b>Overview &amp; Purpose</b> To help students learn how to tell time with a two-handed clock.	<b>Education Standards Addressed</b> K.5.2- Understand concepts of time: morning, afternoon, evening, today, yesterday, tomorrow, week, month, and year. Understand that clocks and calendars are tools that measure time.
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<b>Objectives</b> (Specify skills/information that will be learned.)	The students will learn to tell time using a traditional, two-hand clock.
<b>Materials Needed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Audacity</li><li>• Computer</li></ul>
<b>Verification</b> (Steps to check for student understanding)	The students will be tested over the material in class to check their understanding.
<b>Activity</b> (Describe the independent activity to reinforce this lesson)	The students will log onto the class webpage and click on the assignment link for the Telling Time lesson page. The page will have an interactive clock that the students can move the hands on using their mouse. Using the web application Audacity, the teacher will record his/her voice giving times for the students to show on the clock. The students will move the clock hands to portray the times to practice using a clock to tell time.
