(2nd grade)

<p><i>Overview</i></p>	<p>Students will be listening to music. While listening they will try and identify the different instruments and voices.</p>
<p> <i>Objective</i></p>	<p>Students will learn to identify:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Instruments by sight and sound• Voices (child, adult male, and adult female)• Difference in tempo
<p><i>Standards</i></p>	<p>Listening to, analyzing, and describing music</p> <p>2.6 Students identify similarities and differences in music using movement and musical terms. They recognize groups of classroom and orchestral instruments. They identify and demonstrate appropriate listening behavior.</p>

<p>Procedure</p>	<p>The students will listen to different songs with all types of genre. They will use Blip fm to provide the class with songs. As the students listen to the songs they will have to try and identify as many instruments and voices as possible. The students will be able to listen to songs of their choice as long as they are of different genres. As they continue through have them write down:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Song• Genre• Instruments• voices
<p>Evaluation</p>	<p>The students will be graded on their participation and effort in class. They will be given 10 points. With enough practice the students will be given a quiz which will cover distinguish between the different instruments</p>



and voices they hear in a song.

This quiz will be worth 15 points.
