



Foursquare: Elementary Scavenger Hunt

Overview	The students will be given a list of items they have to find on the playground. Each item will be a badge. Once the item is obtained, the students will log on to Foursquare and get the next item to scavenge for.
Objective	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will learn the different methods of navigating around their surroundings• Students will be able to transition easier into learning their directions, as well as other information about their town.
Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will demonstrate the ability to understand north, south, east, and west.• Students will be able to demonstrate the ability to use a compass in everyday life.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foursquare• Scavenger Hunt list• Compass

<h2>Procedure</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pass out a list of items• Have the students log on to Foursquare• Walk outside with the students• Split the students into groups who have the same item• Have them search for the item using the compass• Repeat.• Homework: Have a great day• Next day in class discuss what we learned <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Key issues to address<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Make sure the students stay together✓ Have all participate
