

FOURSQUARE: FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND CAMPUS



OVERVIEW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The students will be able to use the application Foursquare on their mobile phones and using it to guide themselves around campus.
OBJECTIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will learn how to find their way around the University to respective buildings in which their classes are in. After they reach a building, they can check in to that building and receive points for rewards
STANDARDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Foursquare application: Explain how Foursquare works and how you points are tallied for rewards
MATERIALS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cellular phone Foursquare application List of buildings in which to visit
PROCEDURE PROCEDURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will receive a list of buildings on their University's campus. After they receive their list, they must use Foursquare to guide them to each respective building. Once they reach the building, they must check in to that building using the Foursquare application. This will help them accumulate points on Foursquare. After the student has visited all the buildings on the list, they will return to the building they visited first for their reward
