<p>Overview</p>	<p>Students will become familiar with YouPolls.com.</p>
<p>Objective</p>	<p>Given the lesson and powerpoint presentation on how to use YouPolls.com, students will be able to set up their own YouPolls account, create a poll of their own, and participate in polls from around the world.</p>
<p>Standards</p>	<p>Through experiences with the collection and analysis of data, students can learn to interpret information and determine probabilities that will enable them to make and critically examine statistical arguments</p>
<p>Materials</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A computer with access to the internet.
<p>Procedure</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Present powerpoint presentation about the different uses of YouPolls.com and why people use it. 2. Show students step-by-step how to create an account, create a poll, and participate in other's polls. (This can be done by projecting your computer screen onto a projection screen) 3. Students will then use their computers to complete the tasks asked of them.
<p>Evaluation</p>	<p>Students will write down their account name and the teacher can then look at polls posted by a certain user</p>
