

Current Events: Health Care Bill (S.T.E.M.)

Grade Level: Secondary Juniors and Seniors: AP Government Course

Overview	To inform my students on the new health care bill, how others feel about it and how they feel about it.
Objective	After looking at the two polls with articles/videos on the Health Care Bill, students will write two paragraphs, the first, what the Health Care Bill is and what the government plans it will do for Healthcare, and the second, what the student feels about the bill, are they for it or against it and why, and how others in the United States feel about it (given the poll results), with 100% accuracy.
Standards	
Materials	Computer, URL for youpolls and the two particular polls, pencil/pen and paper
Procedure	The students should be able to figure the lesson out on their own through reading the information that goes along with the polls. The only thing I will give them is the URL youpolls and the two particular polls.
Evaluation	The students will show me if they have learned from the lesson if they write the paragraph with all the requirements.
