

## YouPoll Elementary Education Lesson Plan

### Grades 4-5

<b>Overview</b>	The students will learn how to use a poll website in order to collect data on other students favorite types of dogs. By the end of the lesson, they should know how to create an online poll, read the data, and draw conclusions.
<b>Objective</b>	After creating the online poll, the students will be able to read the poll correctly about their classmates favorite type of dog with 100 percent accuracy.
<b>Standards</b>	Standard 4.1.1. states that students will be able to observe and describe that scientific investigations generally work the same way in different places. This pertains to the children because they will observe which dogs students like and will be able to use the poll in different places but the same way that they did before.
<b>Materials</b>	The students will need a computer, keyboard, and possibly an encyclopedia in order to look up different types of dogs.
<b>Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) I will take the students through a step by step tutorial on how to create a YouPoll website.</li> <li>2) I will have them work together to create their own YouPoll site with their favorite types of dogs</li> <li>3) The students will have children from other classrooms take the poll</li> <li>4) The students will then calculate the results and draw conclusions on what the favorite type of dog is.</li> </ol>
<b>Evaluation</b>	I will have the children show me how the website works, and how they participated in creating the YouPoll
