




Times Tables

Grade Level: 4th Grade

<h2>Overview</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The purpose of this lesson is for students to learn their times tables for the numbers 5 through 8. This lesson will help the students learn all about their times tables in a fun way.
<h2>Objectives</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learn the times tables for the numbers 5 through 8. The students will then be tested on them later on.
<h2>Standards</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 4.2 Students solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of whole numbers and understand the relationships among these operations.
<h2>Materials</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Times table worksheets for each number (5-8) Times table quizzes MyTodos.com
<h2>Procedure</h2> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> You will begin by introducing the children to MyTodos.com. Since they will be learning the times tables for multiple numbers, they will need to organize when they will work on each number and when they need to have it mastered by. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each times table worksheet will need to be completed by a certain day and each quiz will have an assigned day. To keep the children organized they will use MyTodos.com to remember which number is due which day and when each quiz is. The children will then be introduced to the number 5 and its times table. They will complete a worksheet over that number, and will be quizzed on it at the end of the week. Each week the children will be presented with a new number to learn until they reach the number 8 and master that number.
<h2>Evaluation</h2>	<p>After they have mastered the numbers 5 through 8, the children will have a combined test over all the numbers.</p>
