Overview

Students will be making a final project on how to improve campus. They will be in groups of four to five and must come up with a persuasive speech persuading the audience of why they should include their campus fix into their budget.

Objective

The students must persuade the audience that using funding on the students idea of how to improve campus would be a good use of money. The students should learn organizational skills as well as group planning skills using <http://www.plancast.com>.

Learning Environment

The learning environment will be a standard college classroom, however the students must complete steps 2 and 3 outside of the classroom on a computer with internet access.

Material

The students will be providing all of their own materials. This material could range from poster boards for the presentation to examples of their improvements. The students will need to have internet access in order to access and show how they are setting up group meetings using <http://www.plancast.com>.

Procedure

1. A short lecture will be given by the instructor on the project overview.
2. Once the students know how the project will work and who their group members will be, the students will make an account on <http://www.plancast.com>.
3. Once this account is made, they must plan and organize their group meetings and invite the instructor as well.

Evaluation

Evaluation will be based on the end product as well as participation. Participation score will be based largely on the students use of Plancast and the student meeting the required number of meetings. The teachers invitation to the events will be used to ensure that all students in the group respond and group evaluation forms at the end of the project will ensure that everyone abides to their actual response.
