Overview

Students will be making a final project which will be centered around <http://www.plancast.com>. The students goal is to program and create an outside source program that will allow them to create plans on Plancast without the need to go to the website.

Objective

The students must use all of their available tools that that they've learned throughout the year to create a fully functional, free standing, Plancast sign in page. Once signed in, the program should be able to show the exact same thing you could get from logging into Plancast at the actual website.

Learning Environment

The learning environment will be any computer with the necessary programs pre-installed for the students to write their code.

Material

The material should be minimal. Other than creating a Plancast at <http://www.Plancast.com>, the students should be using all digital material in order to create their program.

Procedure

1. A short lecture will be given by the instructor on the project overview.
2. Once the project is described in lecture, a syllabus will be handed out with the exact specifications for the program that will allow remote access to a <http://www.plancast.com> account.
3. Once this account is made, the students have a week to finish their program which involves making it fully functional.

Evaluation

Evaluation will be based solely on the end result. If the end project results in a successful and clean looking remote access capability then full credit will be given.
