| Objective | Students will understand the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How to use Verbapp to coordinate their school work 2. To exchange ideas with their classmates on how to better use task management programs |
| Materials needed | Students will need: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Daily access to the internet 2. A verbapp account 3. A word processing program |
| Procedures/Applications | Students will : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Set-up a Verbapp account and accept their classmates and professor as friends on verbapp. This could be done as a class in a computer lab. 2. Go onto their Verbapp dashboard (their account) and add all their assignments and projects for the week 3. Journal each day about their use of Verbapp as they complete their assignments and whether they felt it helped 4. Students will visit at least five of their classmates pages and make a descriptive comment on what they liked about their classmates' organization of their Verbapp page. 5. Write a 2 to 3 page paper on how they used the program, how it helped or did not help and whether they will use it in the future. |
| Evaluation | Students will be evaluated on: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How often did they use their account throughout the week? (10 points) 2. Whether they the students made five post on classmate pages and how constructive the overall comments were. (20 points) 3. The students analysis of how they used the program, the reasons they give for liking Verbapp or not liking it, and the reason for using it in the furute. |
