

<p><b>Objectives</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be able to define teamwork.</li> <li>• Students will work together to brainstorm 3/4 words that teamwork means to them.</li> <li>• Students will develop three or four positive guidelines for working in a group together.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Materials</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Internet</li> <li>• Computers with webcam.</li> <li>• Paper</li> <li>• Markers</li> </ul>
<p><b>Procedures</b></p>	<p>Part 1: Put students in group with piece of paper and marker. Each group is to brainstorm 3 to 5 words that mean teamwork to them. (5 minutes)</p> <p>Go over some of the words on the front board.</p> <p>Part 2: Each group is to come up with their own definition of teamwork - in a sentence or two what does team work mean to them. (10 minutes)</p> <p>Go around the class ask each group to read their definition.</p> <p>Part 3: Each group will come up with three guidelines for working in groups which will help all groups succeed. (5 minutes)</p> <p>Have the students record them on 12seconds.tv.</p> <p>Part 4: Each group will upload their thoughts and send them to a different group.</p> <p>Part 5: Review the main points of Teamwork</p> <p>Teamwork means we have to be able to work together to share a common goal.</p>
