

# Learning the Alphabet

Elementary Level: Writing

Overview	Students will learn the alphabet using an Animoto video made by objects that they bring in.
Objective	After being shown the alphabet Animoto clip several times throughout a week, students will be able to repeat the alphabet with 100% accuracy.
Learning Environment	The classroom or a computer laboratory if there is no computer or internet access in the classroom.
Types of Students	Students will be at the pre-kindergarten learning level.
Standards	K.1.6 Recognize and name all capital and lowercase letters of the alphabet.
Materials	Computer with internet access.
Procedures	Assign students a letter of the alphabet and have them bring in an item that begins with that letter. Take a picture of each item and make an Animoto video with those photos. Show the students the video several times over a course of a week.
Application	Have the students use a sheet of paper to write down the capital and lowercase letters of the alphabet.
Evaluation	Evaluate each student on their own by having them repeat the alphabet to you in private. Then have them pull out a sheet of paper and write down the capital and lowercase letters while you say them.
