

## Bringing Technology to the Classroom

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<b>Brief Description</b>	Students will watch a speech on TED and then write a short essay over their thoughts on what was presented.
<b>Grade/Subject</b>	Elementary Level:  Educational Technology Vocational Education--Computers
<b>Materials Needed</b>	-Computer, Internet connection OR a Projector (if you want the class to all view it at the same time)
<b>Learning Environment</b>	A room with a projector or enough computer screen for every student so all the students can watch the speech.
<b>Types of Students</b>	All the students should be somewhat interested in technology, but what is shown in the video and what the students will be discussing will apply to anyone.
<b>Objectives</b>	Students will...  ...think about using basic technology in new ways. ...think about the ethics of hacking.
<b>Procedure</b>	Have the students watch this TED speech. <a href="http://www.ted.com/talks/johnny_lee_demos_wii_remote_hacks.html">http://www.ted.com/talks/johnny_lee_demos_wii_remote_hacks.html</a>  Once the speech is finished have a quick class discussion about what was just watched. Answer any questions the students might have and then present them with a few simple questions:  1. Why do you think it is important for people like Mr. Lee to spread this kind of knowledge?  2. What Mr. Lee did is considered hacking, but he says that he is showing this off so schools can use this technology. What do you think about the ethics of Mr. Lee's actions?  After presenting the class with the questions, have each student write a short essay answering these questions. OR you can pose these questions towards the class and have a class discussion over them instead of writing the essay.  <u>ADVANCED:</u> After completing the essay, if you feel your class is up to it and you have both the time and money to do it, you can try and put together one of the digital whiteboards used in the video.
