

How to Get Ready In The Morning

Special Education Grades 9-12

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Overview: The students will learn how to get ready in the morning using the application Intodit. I will create a page that has links using different pictures of a hairbrush, toothbrush, clothes, deodorant, and shoes. Using these links, the students will be able to go to separate pages that show someone brushing their hair, brushing their teeth, verbally explaining how clothes go on, putting on deodorant, and tying their shoes.

Evaluation: Students will have learned the process of getting ready in the morning. This exercise will help them remember the steps we have gone through previously on how to get ready in the morning. It will also give them a better visual which will help them match items to the process of getting ready in the morning.

Standards: The students will know how to get ready in the morning. They will be able to use the application to show their new knowledge, and click on the correct link when I ask which item would be used for which part of getting ready in the morning.

Objectives: By the end of this activity, students will be able to:

- Use the Intodit application to learn how to get ready in the morning
- Show the teacher which pictures go with which instructions
- Have a better understanding of how to get ready in the morning

Procedure:

1. The students will each sit at a computer in the computer lab and bring up the website I have created
2. The students will each start by clicking on the different pictures on the screen to learn about which items are used for what
3. Once the students think they know which pictures are used for what, they will raise their hand and call me over.
4. I will ask them questions on which pictures are used for what and once they are able to get all of them right they will be done with the exercise.
