<p>During this lesson, the teacher will not interfere with the students unless entirely necessary. The point of this lesson is for students to figure things out on their own without the help of their teacher or peers. Students should be able to understand Intodit as they do any other common computer function.</p>			
Time	Lesson Sequence	Equipment/Assessment	
	<p>Introduction:</p> <p>Students will create their own Intodit account and learn how to use it on their own. There will be no help from peers or teachers on understanding the wiki. Students will then create their own website on a topic that they are interested in through Intodit. They will research information, put in graphics, videos, and any link that may be appropriate. The purpose of this lesson is to get students familiar with figuring out the Intodit technology on their own while using their creativity to inspire others through original websites.</p>	<p>(See below)</p>	

<p>Closure:</p> <p>After creating their website, each student will do a ten minute presentation about their website, information, how they found it, what struggles they encountered, and what they found to be easy. This presentation will not only help students explain the work that they had been doing, but it will also help them to become more comfortable with speaking in front of a group of people.</p>	<p>The presentation and website will be the assessment to see just how much students learned about using Intodit.</p>
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
