

## Lesson Plan – Intodit Discussion

Equipment: One computer for students in a class to share.

Not only will this allow students to become more familiar with technology, this also gives them more experience in better expressing their thoughts through writing.</b></p>		
<p>Teacher Performance Objectives: <i>During the lesson, the teacher will:</i></p> <p><b>During this lesson, the teacher will oversee the student using the computer. They will not interfere unless assistance is needed. This gives students the chance to figure things out on their own. It will encourage their curiosity with finding and understanding more opportunities that wiki offers.</b></p>			
Time	Lesson Sequence	Equipment/Assessment	
	<p><b>Introduction:</b></p> <p>One student will go to a computer and work with the wiki, Intodit. The teacher will have Intodit logged in and ready for the students on the home page. The student will need to find the “discussion” page and click on it. They will then be expected to write a discussion post on what they want to be/do when they grow up. When they are done with writing the post, they will then return back to the homepage and inform the next student that it is their turn.</p>	<p>(See below)</p>	

**Closure:**

After creating their website, each student will do a ten minute presentation about their website, information, how they found it, what struggles they encountered, and what they found to be easy. This presentation will not only help students explain the work that they had been doing, but it will also help them to become more comfortable with speaking in front of a group of people.

The discussion post will be each student's assessment.

This will combine technology and writing to reveal to the teacher how much their class knows about both topics.
