

# Verb and Nouns Search

Elementary English  
Grades 2-3

<i>Overview</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Students will learn how to locate noun and verbs in a sentence, and also be able to identify the type.</i></li></ul>
<i>Objective</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Students will effectively use Crocodoc.com<sup>1</sup> to locate nouns and verbs.</i></li><li>• <i>Students will be able to identify what type of noun (person, place, thing, Proper, common) as well as what type of verb tense (past, present)</i></li></ul>
<i>Standards<sup>2</sup></i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2.4.2 Organize related ideas together to maintain a consistent focus.</li><li>• 2.4.5/3.4.5 Use a computer to draft, revise, and publish writing.</li><li>• 2.4.6/3.4.6 Review, evaluate, and revise writing for meaning and clarity.</li><li>• 2.4.7/3.4.7 Proofread one's own writing, as well as that of others, using an editing checklist or list of rules.</li></ul>
<i>Materials</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Computer with Internet</i></li></ul>
<i>Procedure</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>After a brief review and nouns, noun types, verbs, and verb tenses, students will follow a URL provided by their teacher to a Crocodoc worksheet.</i></li><li>• <i>Students will first go through and use Crocodoc's highlight feature, and highlight all nouns.</i></li><li>• <i>After highlighting the nouns, students will revisit the highlighted nouns and use Crocodoc's text feature to identify each noun as a person, place, or thing, as well</i></li></ul>

	<p><i>as a common or Proper noun.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Once finished with the nouns, students will use Crocodoc's strikeouts feature to identify all the verbs.</i></li><li>• <i>Once the verbs have been identified, students will revisit the verbs and use the add text feature to identify the verb tense of each verb.</i></li><li>• <i>Students will pair up with another student and proofread each other's worksheet.</i></li><li>• <i>Using the sticky note feature, students will add comments to areas where they feel their peer is incorrect.</i></li><li>• <i>Students will go back to their own worksheet and make necessary changes.</i></li></ul>
<p><i>Evaluation</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Students are evaluated on the comments given to their peers, and if the suggestions they make are correct.</i></li><li>• <i>The worksheets will be graded by the teacher (who has each URL) and will be graded on the corrections made.</i></li></ul>
