

American Revolution Using Stixy

Objective	The students will learn how to use Stixy by being able to learn about the American Revolution. The students will be able to access the lecture notes, as well as, view pictures that depict the American Revolution. The students also will be able to discuss what they learned and receive their assignment through Stixy. The eleventh grade students will be able to view their upcoming quiz and access study material.
Learning Environment	The students will work individually at a personal or lab computer. They will use Stixy through the Internet.
Types of Students	The students will be in high school, specially 11 th grade.
Standards	This full fills the Indiana Standards: USH 1, the students will read key documents that explain individuals rights, government, and the general welfare in the founding era .
Materials	Personal or lab computer with internet access, Stixy.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The teacher will sign each student up for a Stixy account.2. Go through the Stixy website and instruct the students on how to use Stixy.3. After the students have learned how to use the program, they will access it outside or during class.4. After the students have finished studying the American Revolution they will write a 3-5 page paper. They may use the information available on Stixy to complete this task.
Application	After learning how to use Stixy, the students will use the application to complete the assignment.
Evaluation	The students will be tested over the material on Stixy, with 95% success rate. The test will be an essay format.
