

Using Plurk in College

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| Grade Level / Subject | College Level / Education & Technology |
| Objectives | Students will understand the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How to use plurk in an efficient way. 2. Discuss topics outside of class, with students in their class and internationally. |
| Materials | For the lesson, you will need: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Internet Access 2. Plurk Account |
| Procedures/ Application | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have students set up a Plurk account in class, for free. Let them customize it and make it their own. Then make sure they have added all their classmates as friends. 2. Give them assignments to write their views and opinions on. Make a date and time that they have to have it posted, or “Plurked” by. 3. Give them a second task. After they have Plurked their views and opinions on the subject, have them comment on one or two other Purks made by their classmates. They have to have a descriptive comment, not just “good idea”. |
| Evaluation | <p><i>Part one</i> (Plurking own opinion): 10 points- Finished on time, written a descriptive opinion. 5 points- Late, but written well 0 points- Late, Lacking in description or not even posted.</p> <p><i>Part two</i> (Commenting on other’s Plurks) 10 points- Finished on time, gave descriptive feedback 5 points- Late, descriptive feedback 0 points- Late, no feedback, or not even attempted</p> |
