

	Literature Peer Review
Objective	The students will be divided into groups and will learn how to use Facebook Chat by chatting with a partner. They will chat after they have peer reviewed each other's papers on the novel <u>A Farewell to Arms</u> .
Learning Environment	The students will work in groups at a lab computer. They will use Facebook Chat through Facebook on the internet.
Types of Students	The students will be in post-secondary education and in an english or literature class.
Standards	Literature (Literary Analysis and Criticism of Fiction): LIT.3
Materials	Lab computer with internet access, Facebook Chat, partner, <u>A Farewell to Arms</u> , and their paper written on <u>A Farewell to Arms</u> .
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If they do not have a Facebook account already, the students will sign up for Facebook in order to use Facebook Chat. 2. The students will choose a partner that they will work with for the lesson. 3. The partners will peer review each other's literary analysis papers they have written on the novel <u>A Farewell to Arms</u>. 4. The students will use Facebook Chat to talk about the peer review and give suggestions for the literary analysis. 5. The students will then write a summary of the experience of peer reviewing by describing the suggestions they gave for their partner's paper and the suggestions they were given for their own paper.
Application	After learning how to use Facebook Chat, the partners will peer review each other's papers and chat about it on the program.
