



Food Photo-Shoot

Objective:	The objective of this lesson plan is for students to learn to use Twitpic by uploading the photos they have taken of their food to share with their classmates.
Materials:	<p>Materials include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Digital camera • Computers • Meals for children to take pictures of
Students:	This activity would work for students' grades 4-6.
Procedure:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Teacher will need to explain the objective of this activity and a quick demonstration of how Twitpic will be incorporated into the lesson. 2. The teacher and students will all create a Twitpic account that they will need later work on in the activity. 3. The students will need to have a camera so that they can take pictures of every meal that they eat for two days. 4. Once those two days are over, the students will be asked to bring their cameras to school so they can upload their photos to Twitpic (this does not need to be done at school, but it could be useful to have the teachers help) 5. Once each child has uploaded their pictures onto Twitpic, give each child a chance to go to other students account and look at their pictures. 6. The child will then choose two other students photos to write about, and they are to write a paragraph for each student they choose. 7. The paragraph is just an overview of the photos and whether or not they think the student ate healthy that day or not. (Make sure the students consider what they have learned about portions and value of certain foods.)
Evaluation:	<p>The student will be graded based on the pictures they took and uploaded = 15 points</p> <p>The students will be graded on both evaluations they write on other students pictures = 10 points</p>
