

<p>Objectives:</p>	<p>Students will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Demonstrate an understanding of their locations culture as well as include 2 significant holidays in their presentation 2. Use a Picture Editing Application (Picasa) to add text captions or titles, rotate/crop photos, and change the color effect (Black and white/emphasis on a certain color) to at least 3 pictures in their presentation
<p>Materials:</p>	<p>Students will need:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Computers equipped with Picasa 2. Construction paper/glue/stickers/scrapbooking materials
<p>Procedures:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Create a document that lists each student's location assignment 2. Hand out the cultural exploration assignment paper to the students and explain the process of researching their location 3. Allow students time in class to research their location 4. Edit pictures and print 5. Assemble Scrapbook 6. Present Scrapbook to class

Dear Students,

For our next unit, we will be focusing on different cultures around the world. Each one of you will create a “scrapbook” to present to the class after you complete your cultural exploration. In your scrapbook you must include:

- A title page with your location and your name
- 3 pages with location information (ex. Population size, capital city [if applicable], date of establishment/independence, popular religion, most prominent language)
- 1 page with a comparison between your assigned location and the United States
- 2 significant holidays for your location
- 10 pictures that illustrate the information in your scrapbook
 - o These pictures **must include** one picture that has text added, one that is cropped or rotated, and 2 that have some type of color effect (Black and White/ Emphasis on a certain color)

This is due one month from today on **November 17,2011**. We will be having 2 work days in class.
