

	GoogleDocs Secondary Lesson Plan: Book Review
Overview	Due to the need for AP Literature students to know as many texts as possible, each student will read a canonical book and write a report on it. All students will be able to read each other reviews through GoogleDocs sharing. The instructor will prepare a quiz based on the book summaries.
Objective	For students to read a book, write a summary of the book, and to read all of the other summaries in order to maximize their knowledge of classical literature.
Learning Environment	Students will work on this project on their own time, but will be given some time for in-class reading.
Description of Students	Students are 11 th and 12 th grade AP Literature students.
Standards	This project will satisfy Indiana's Academic Standard 1a and b for Reading and Comprehension.
Materials	Access to research materials, including assigned book and internet. Internet access for GoogleDocs.
Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The teacher gives directions for the project 2. Each student reads his or her assigned book 3. After reading, the student writes about his or her book, gives a full summary with detailed analysis 4. The students all share their documents on GoogleDocs 5. The students read and study the summaries, preparing for a quiz over all of the books 6. The instructor uses the summaries on GoogleDocs to write questions for the quizzes 7. The instructor gives a quiz
Evaluation	Students will be graded based on the instructor's desired level of thoroughness, as based on a rubric for the summaries and will be graded on a scale of 25 points for the quiz.
