



# Lesson plan: Firefighters

<b>Outlook</b>	Today, we will be reading Curious George and the Firefighters and talk about the role of a firefighter in the community. We will be using seismic to communicate via video with firefighters.
<b>Materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Curious George and the Firefighters</li> <li>✓ Computers</li> <li>✓ White board</li> </ul>
<b>Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. During circle time we will read Curious George and the Firefighters written by Margret and H. A. Rey.</li> <li>2. We will discuss the roles of a firefighter in the community. We will discuss what they do, how they do it and how to contact them in case of an emergency.</li> <li>3. After our discussion we will use the website, Seismic, to view videos of actually fire fighters explaining what they do, why they have chosen this career and why they want to help.</li> <li>4. We will then put video tape and post a video on Seismic, thanking all firemen for their service.</li> </ol>
<b>Evaluation</b>	To evaluate the children after our fireman activity, send home, prompting the children to explain to their parents how we used Seismic to explore the career of fighting fires.
