

Amendment Research Paper

Objectives	Students will be required to choose from amendments 11-27 of the constitution and will then write a research paper on the events surrounding that amendment and the reasons why that change was thought necessary. Students will be given a Remember the Milk list to organize the tasks they need to complete and to help them keep track of the due dates for each task on the RTM list. Students will also be required to complete and submit a work cited page.
Learning Environment	Students will be working using the internet, a RTM account, and the library to complete their research. The RTM account will be used to assign students task list and to help them keep track of due dates.
Student Target	Students in middle school who are studying U.S. History

Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will pick the amendment they wish to research. 2. A quick lesson will be given on Remember the Milk, and a task list will be sent to each student's Remember the Milk account. 3. Time will be set aside for the students to use the internet and the library to research their amendment. 4. Time will also be set aside for the students to write up their papers.
