

	Lobes of the Brain
Objective	The students will be split into groups of four. Each group will be responsible for and primarily focus on two different lobes of the brain and they will know their function. They will be expected to use a task list through Remember the Milk. After the allotted amount of time to work on this project, the groups will present their two lobes to the class.
Learning Environment	The students will work in groups of four each. They will use Remember the Milk on a lab or personal computer with the internet.
Types of Students	The students will be in post-secondary education and in a science or anatomy course.
Standards	N/A
Materials	Lab or personal computer with internet access, information about the lobes of the brain, and Remember the Milk.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The teacher will split the class into groups with four people in each group. Each group will then be assigned two lobes of the brain to study (more than one group might have the same topic). 2. The students will need to sign up for Remember the Milk and then they will also need to learn how to use Remember the Milk. 3. Students will then be asked to use Remember the Milk to make a list of things they need to accomplish in order to complete their report on time. 4. After the groups have compiled their information and have completed their tasks, they will present their topic to their peers.
Application	After learning how to use Remember the Milk, the students will use the program to list the things they need to accomplish in order to complete their presentation on time.
Evaluation	<p>Visual aid (PowerPoint, poster, puppet show, etc...) = 30 points</p> <p>Presentation skills (looking at audience, language, keeping audience hooked) = 30</p> <p>Valid and relevant information given = 40 points</p> <p>Total = 100 points</p>
