

	Extreme Vocabulary
Objective	The students will learn a list of ten new vocabulary words each week during the lesson unit. They will create a list of the words on the program Remember the Milk. Through this program, they will keep track of which words they have learned and which ones they need to work on. It will be up to the students to determine when they have fully learned a word.
Learning Environment	The students will work individually on learning their list of vocabulary words. They will use a personal or lab computer to utilize Remember the Milk.
Types of Students	The students will be in post-secondary education and in an english course.
Standards	English/Language Arts (Word Recognition, Fluency, and Vocabulary Development): 6.1
Materials	Lab or personal computer with internet access, list of ten vocabulary words per week, and Remember the Milk.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will be given a list of ten vocabulary words each week during the lesson unit in which they will need to learn. 2. The students will need to sign up for Remember the Milk and then they will also need to learn how to use Remember the Milk. 3. Students will then be asked to use Remember the Milk to make a list of the words and to keep a check list of whether they have learned the word or not. It will be up to the students to keep track of this because they will be quizzed every Friday over the list of words.
Application	After learning how to use Remember the Milk, the students will use the program to keep track of their knowledge of the ten vocabulary words for the week.
Evaluation	<p>The students will be quizzed upon their knowledge of the list of ten words every week. The quizzes will be worth 10 points each.</p> <p>At the end of the unit, the students will be tested upon all of the words. The test will be worth 50 points.</p>
