**Project Title**

**English: Diigo Group Introductions**

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| Objective            | Students will:<br>Work together in groups of 3-4 making a profile page on Diigo. They will introduce the group members, telling their hobbies and interests, and also including pictures and graphics  |
| Learning Environment | The students will use the computer lab and if necessary, their own personal computer.  |
| Types of Students    | The students involved in the project will be 5 <sup>th</sup> - 6 <sup>th</sup> graders that being introduced to using Diigo for the first time.  |
| Standards            | ISTE: 1,2,4  |
| Materials            | Notebooks for each student.<br>Computer and lab use for each student.<br>Diigo account   |
| Procedures           | <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Students will get in groups of 3-4 assigned by the teacher.</li><li>2. Together they will create a profile page of their individual groups.</li><li>3. They will include pictures, graphics, their interests, hobbies, sibling, pet, or any other information they would like to add.</li><li>4. They will use creativity with background colors, fonts, and other ideas.</li></ol> Once the class has finished they will present their profile page as a group |
| Application          | This is to help introduce the idea of group work to children who have not relied on group work as much prior to this experience.   |
| Evaluation           | The students will be evaluated based on the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. They will be scored based on their level of creativity, such as graphics and pictures, along with content on the profile page, such as group name, members, and personal information.</li></ol>  |
