

A Fish's Blog

Grade Level: 4



<p>OBJECTIVES</p>	<p>Students will create a blog in the perspective of their favorite saltwater fish.</p>
<p>MATERIALS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research over a type of saltwater fish • Access to EduBlogs
<p>PROCEDURES</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will choose the type of fish they wish to create their blog over. 2. Students will make blog posts. One for each topic: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What the fish eats • Where the fish lives • Who the fish's predators are 3. Each post should have a picture and should have a paragraph written about the topic.
<p>ASSESSMENT</p>	<p>I will read each of the students' blog posts to see if they wrote about each topic and made the correct amount of posts. I also will make sure there is a picture and that the paragraphs show that they did research about the topic.</p>
