Key Focus: Edublogs

Grade Level: Teachers

<b>Overview</b>	Edublogs will offer a way of communication through the workplace, providing for a more efficient school community.
<b>Objective</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• From a workplace standpoint, teachers will develop skills in communicating with the faculty and staff working in their school system.</li></ul>
<b>Standards</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teachers will use the website Edublogs to communicate with fellow teachers and other education majors, to better their classroom.</li></ul>
<b>Materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A computer</li><li>• Internet access</li><li>• An Edublogs account</li></ul>
<b>Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Teachers will arrive to the seminar about Edublogs.</li><li>2. Teachers will take notes about the website Edublogs.</li><li>3. Teachers will then log on to the website Edublogs and create an account.</li><li>4. Teachers will connect with other teachers through Edublogs.</li></ol>
<b>Evaluation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For their evaluation, teachers will need to have participated in the seminar discussions, and contribute to the discussion.</li><li>• For homework, teachers will be assigned nightly blogging with a worksheet; teachers must have the worksheet completed on order to receive points for the day.</li><li>• At the end of the class, teachers will also take a quiz that evaluates the appropriate material that must be obtained.</li><li>• Finally teachers will also be evaluated based on attendance, students that miss class regularly, will suffer a grade deduction, while on the other hand teachers that attend all classes will receive a bonus.</li></ul>
