<b>Overview</b>	Mechanics can address questions and find helpful information on the best way to fix car troubles by posting blogs and pictures on Windows Live Writer.
<b>Objective</b>	Given a computer with Windows Live Writer, mechanics from a local body shop will look up information on how to fix a certain car properly and post pictures of that car. The development of the blog will allow the mechanics to find support and suggestions for successfully fixing a variety of car problems.
