

## Elementary Education Lesson Plan

	<b>When I Get Older, I Want to Be...</b>
<b>Overview</b>	Students will learn to use Windows Live Writer by posting a blog with pictures about what they want to be when they get older.
<b>Objective</b>	Given a computer and the Windows Live Writer program, the students will be able to explore possible career fields and create a post about the ones they find most interesting. The completed blog will be free of errors.
<b>Standards</b>	2.4.5: Use a computer to draft, revise, and publish writing. 3.4.8: Revise writing for others to read, improving the focus and progression of ideas. 3.4.1: Find ideas for writing stories and descriptions in conversations with others; in books, magazines, or school textbooks; or on the Internet.
<b>Materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Windows Live Writer</li><li>• Computer with Internet access</li></ul>
<b>Procedure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ask students to sit down in a seat with a computer</li><li>• Show the class how to use Windows Live Writer</li><li>• Tell the class to write about what career they would like to have when older<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Instruct them to add pictures and words</li></ul></li><li>• Ask class to share with a friend after completion</li></ul>
<b>Evaluation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If the student completed exercise correctly give him or her 10 points</li><li>• If the student did not complete exercise but tried give him or her 5 points</li><li>• If the student did not complete exercise give him or her 0 points</li></ul>
