Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will have been working on international cooking projects in the classroom. 2. Student will be asked to GoogleLit trip their recipe's foundation on the Lit Trip. 3. As students finish, the group will see how close and far away their foods are linked 4. Students will answer question on a worksheet based on the information presented in the Google Lit Trip.
Evaluation	Students will be graded on their correct completion of the worksheet and behavior exhibited during the procedure.
